- Over 430 aYSC registered participants
- Over 175 First Nation communities
- Vision to provide @YourSide Colleague to every First Nation community requesting access
- SEHC is actively seeking funding for continued expansion and ongoing sustainability
- Grassroots initiative continues to grow!





Relationship with FN

- First Nations were early adopters and have been instrumental in helping to shape the ongoing evolution of aYSC
- In 2000, SEHC was approached by First Nations in Manitoba to share aYSC with a number of communities looking for innovative solutions to improve health services at a local level
- First Nations provide input on content and suggestions for adapting the program to meet their needs
- First Nations participate in an advisory capacity and represent aYSC on provincial aYSC Champion networks







- Several week commitment

- Pre and post testing for learner self evaluation


























2 Levels of Recognition

Evaluation Methods

Evaluation strategies:

- Survey monkey
 - Anonymous
 - 4 key areas of focus
 - Quantitative & qualitative
- Meeting notes
 - With permission
- Independent comments
 - Feedback in aYSC





Evaluation Highlights

- n=13, 84.6% response rate (all questions)
- 89% of participants felt blended approach helped them succeed in their learning
- 90.9% participants report positive impact of study group and learning to practice
- 81.8% found continued support through the study group format assisted learning
- 72.3% found the online CoL beneficial in learning
