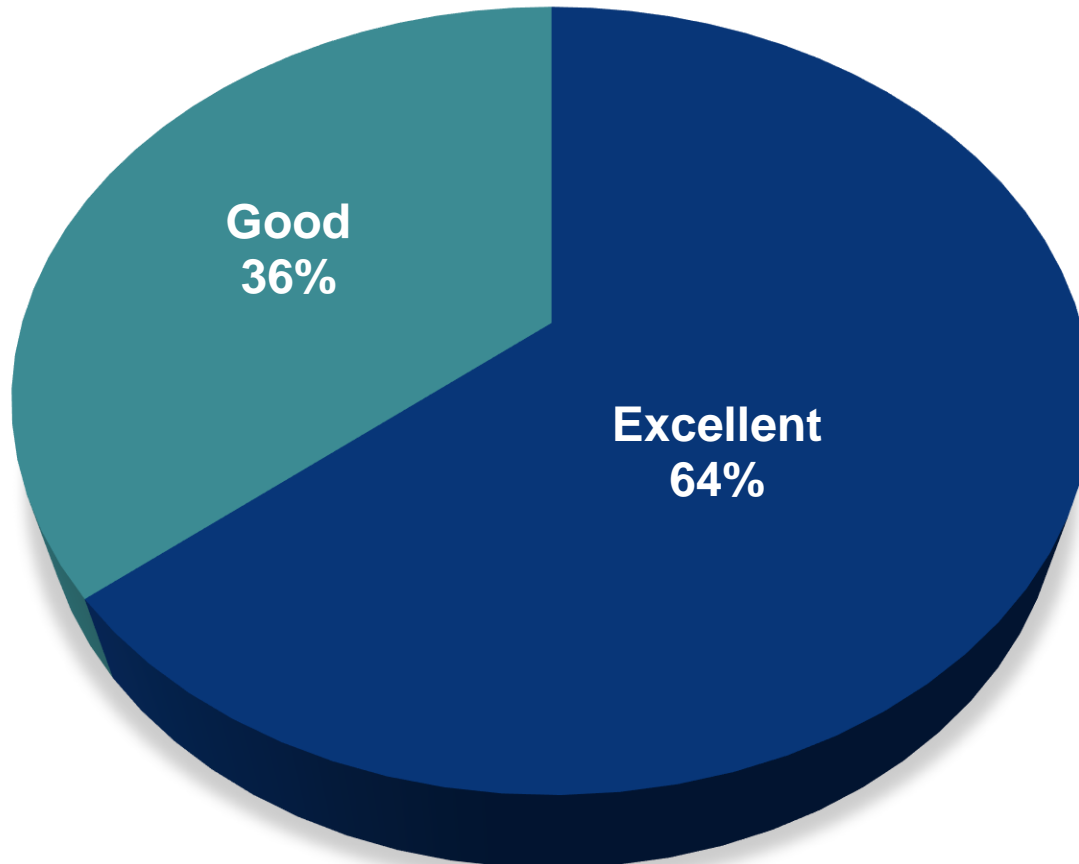

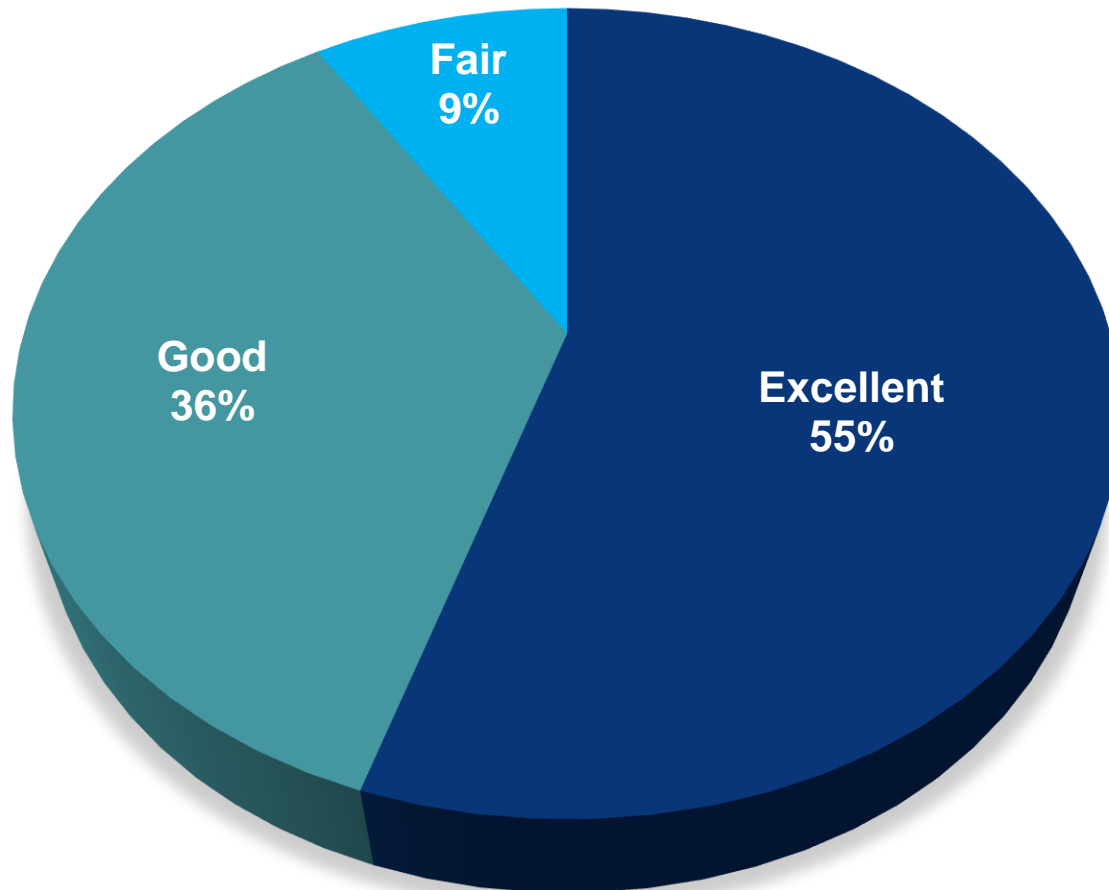
CNA Post-Exam Evaluation Results



Frequency, Facilitation and Use of Webinars (N=11)

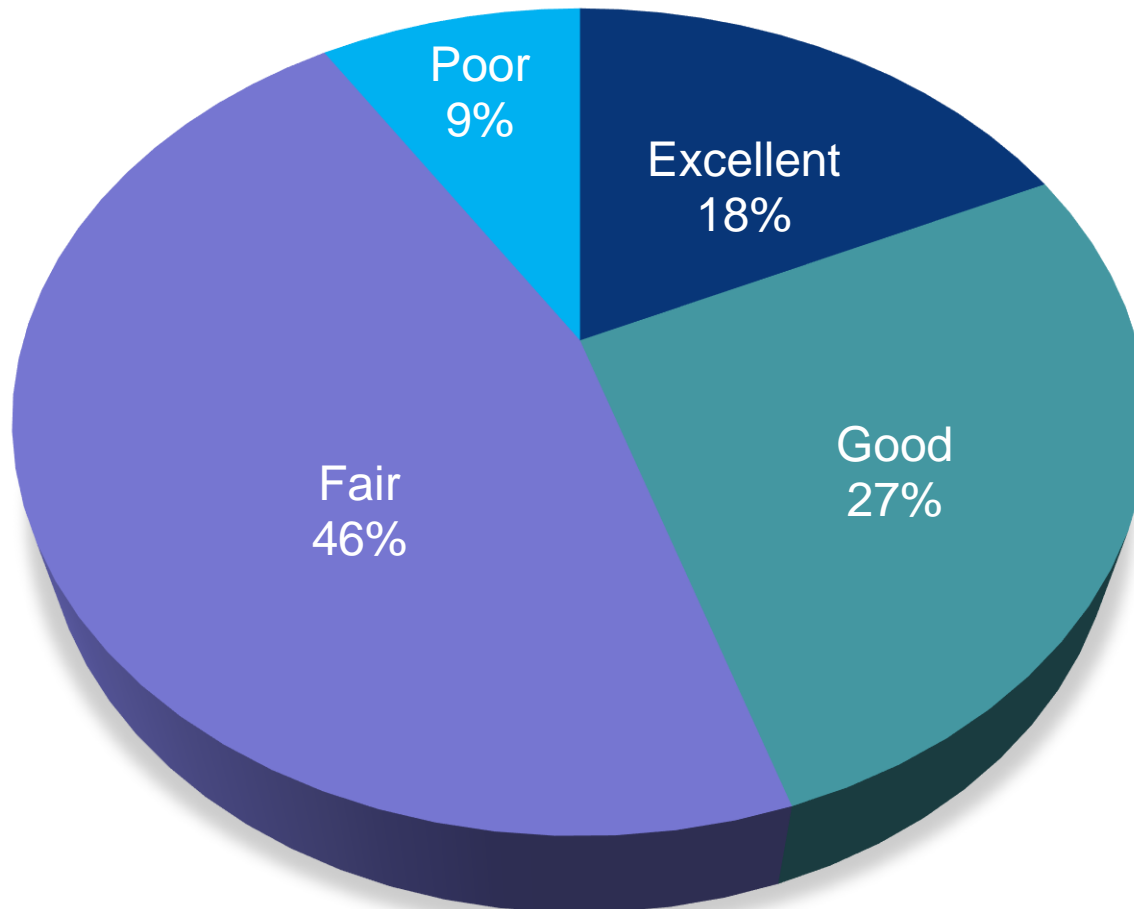


Use of Cloud Technology (N=11)
